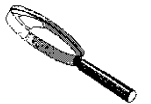

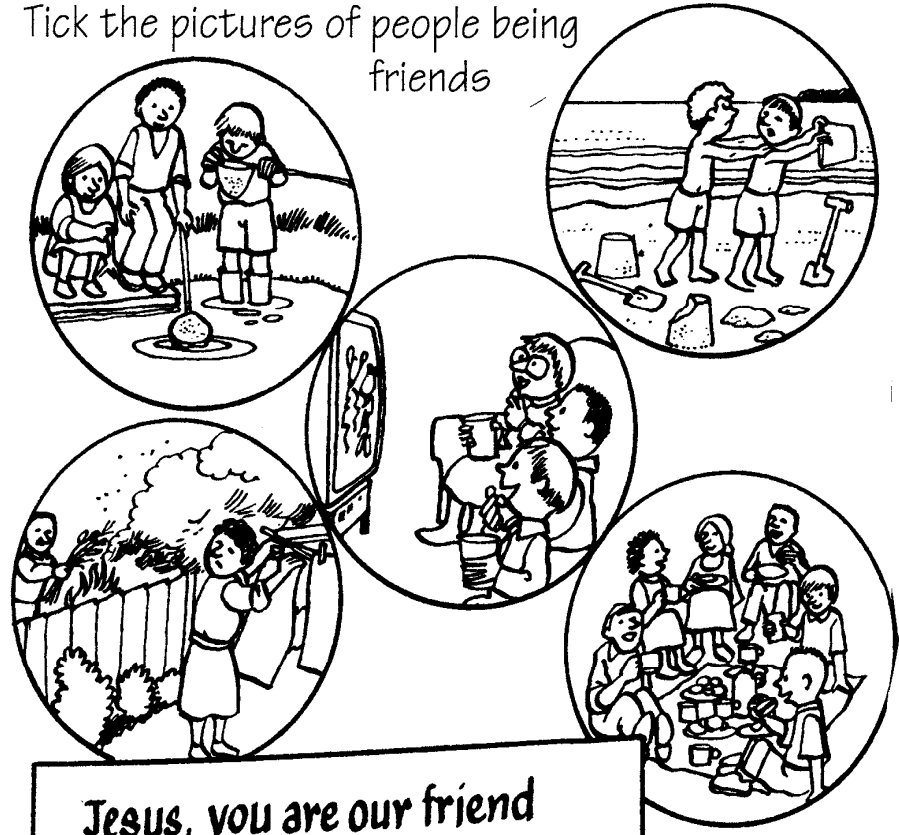


APPOINTED TO BEAR FRUIT

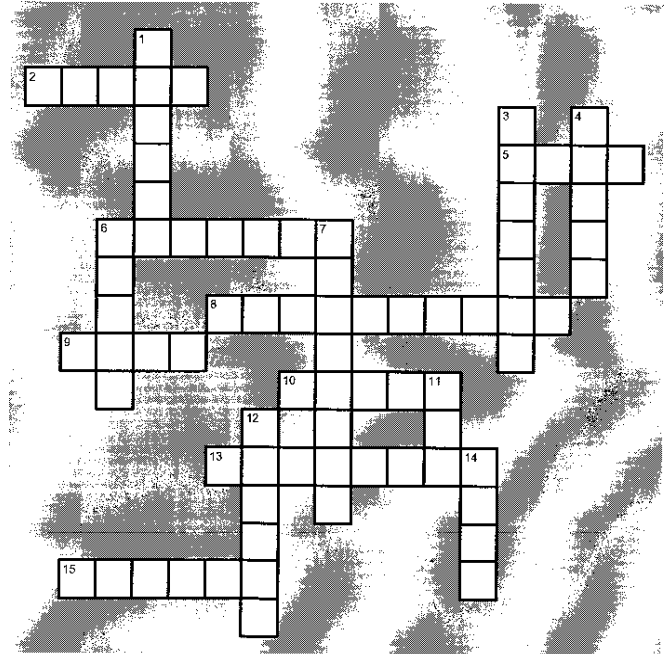
