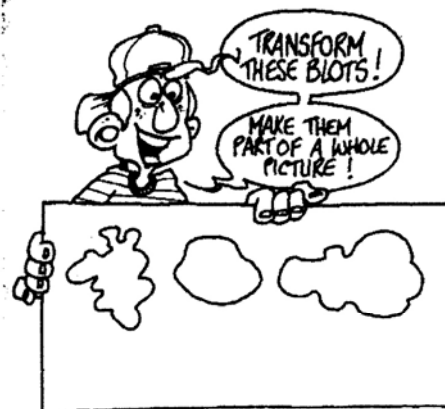


The Day of Pentecost 19 May, 2024

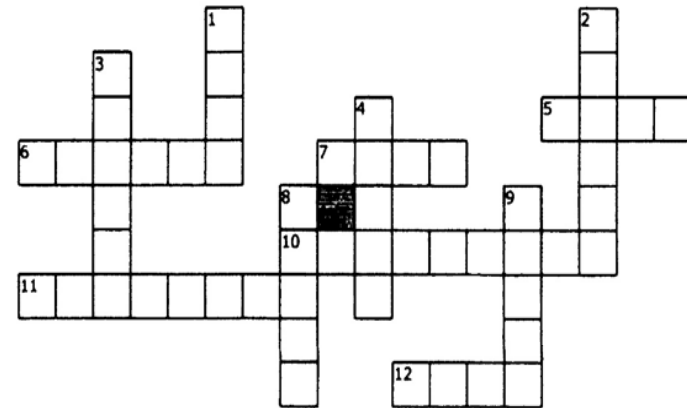
