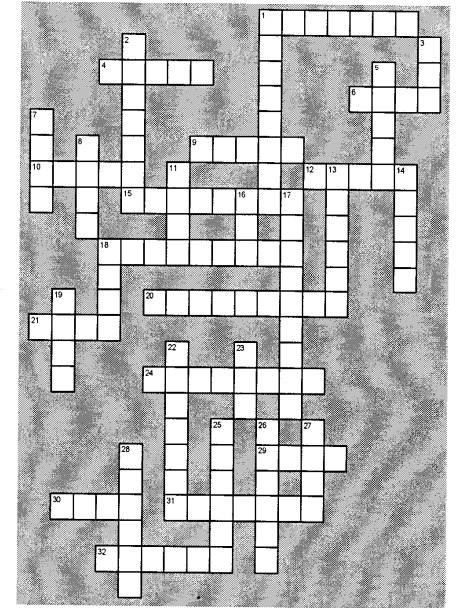

Not in itself, no. But it was one person's willingness to be generous, and God can do a lot with that.

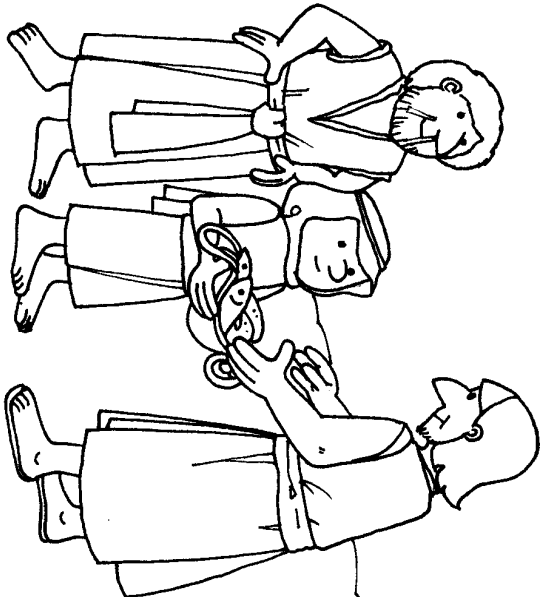

Yes! And when you get to heaven you'll see just how many people were blessed through your giving!



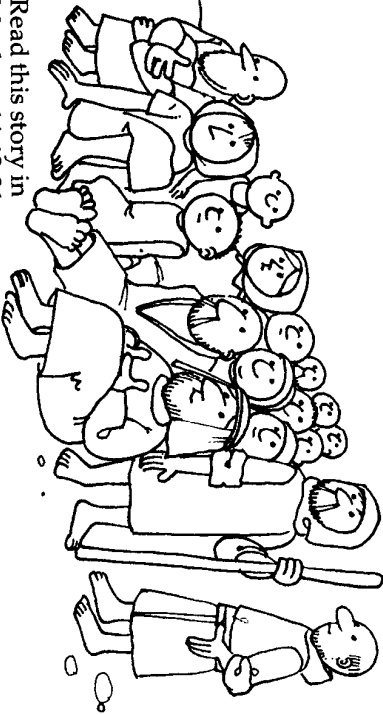

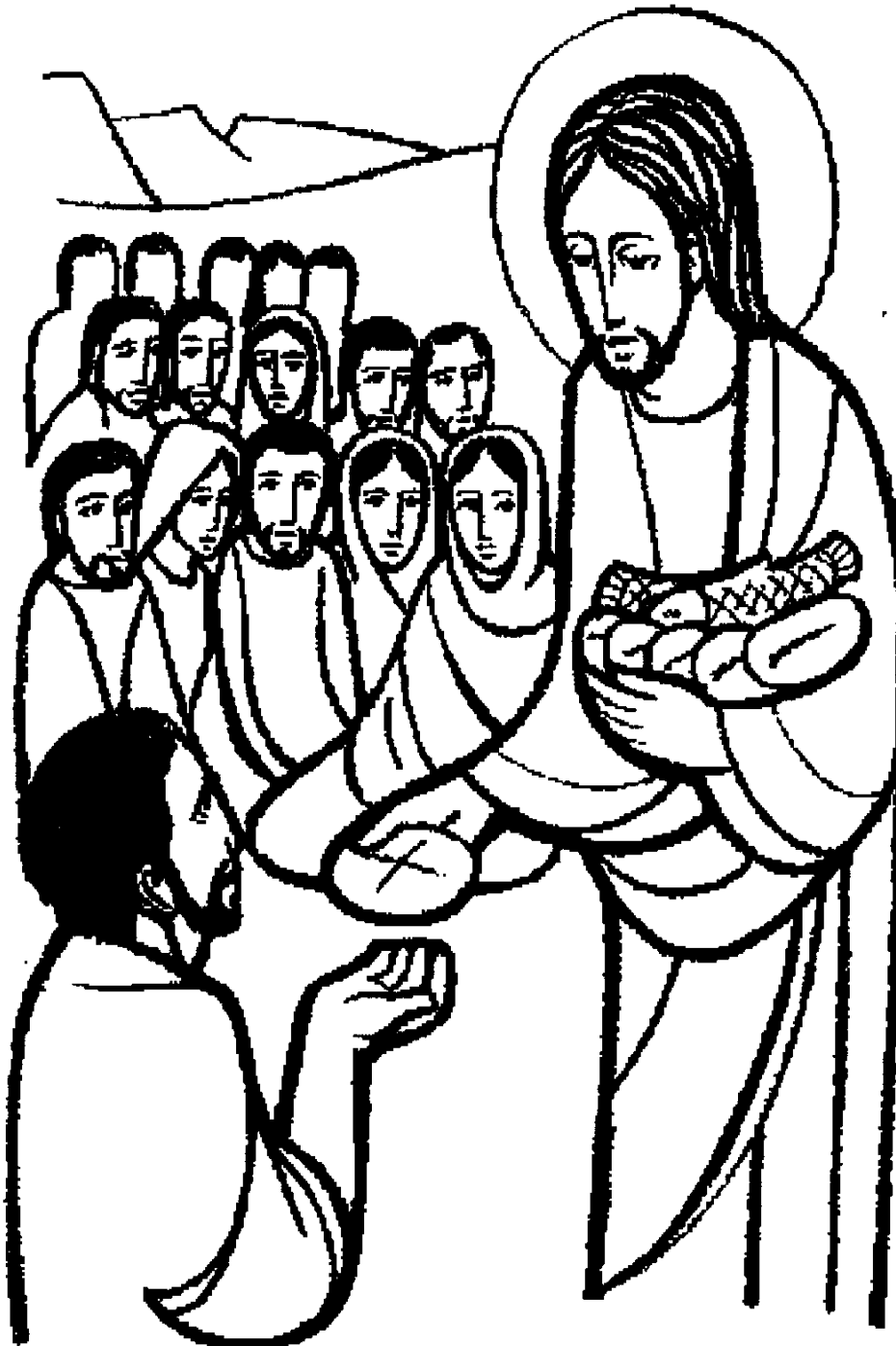
